



Don't Let a Fall Ruin Your Fall

Improper fall protection is currently the number one OSHA violation. Falls from elevations account for many workplace injuries each year.

Work at heights greater than or equal to four (4) feet above a working surface requires the use of fall protection. These areas should be inspected by a Competent Person or EHS to ensure proper protection.



Anchorage

Anchorage devices provide a secure point of attachment to an existing structure for the fall protection system.



Body Support

Full body harnesses connect the worker to the fall protection system.



Connector

Connectors are devices that connect the full body harness to the anchorage system.
