## Utility Vehicle Safety

- 1 Read the owner's manual and follow safety labels.
- All occupants must wear seat belts and keep legs and arms inside the vehicle at all times.
- Use the correct lighting, marking, and reflectors to warn other drivers when operating near roadways or equipment.
- 4) Use the appropriate speed on rough terrain.
- 5 Stopping distance increases with speed and weight of a towed load.
- 6 Make sure cargo or material is properly secured during transport.
- When backing up, always check for obstacles or people behind the machine.
- 8 Drive completely up or down a slope before making a turn.
- Be cautious of traffic when operating near or crossing roadways.
- Use care when approaching blind corners or areas that obscure vision.
- 11 Stay clear of ditches and embankments.
